Young Artist • Young Artist Studio

5 – 6 PM | *Recommended for artists ages 5 and up*

Every artist begins somewhere! Young Artist Studio introduces children to the exciting world of visual art through playful, hands-on projects that encourage creativity, confidence, and self-expression. Young artists explore drawing, painting, sculpture, collage, printmaking, and mixed media while developing foundational artistic skills in a fun, welcoming studio environment. Studio Artist • Art Exploration

6 – 7 PM | *Recommended for artists ages 8 and up*

Young Artist • Painting

5 – 6PM | *Recommended for artists ages 5 and up*

Master Artist • Realism & Technique

Young Artist • Illustration

5 – 6 PM | *Recommended for artists ages 5 and up*
